Hybrid Instruction:

- Must have AEPP approval
- WIOA (Literacy Classes only)
- Does not apply to Case Management, Assessments, or Vocational Training
- ALE Literacy Classes
- EPE only applies to the tutoring associated with EPE Distance Education packet programs

Hybrid Instruction:

- In person classes must meet for 50% (minimum) of class scheduled time
- Remote Learning portion cannot exceed 50% (maximum) of class scheduled time (must be synchronous instruction)
- Distance and In-person cannot take place at the same time (live streaming is not an option)
- Must be the same teacher for both in-person and remote synchronous
- If a student misses 3 consecutive in-person classes, the program must warn the student they will be removed from the remote class

Hybrid Instruction:

- Programs approved for Hybrid Instruction must send their remote links/platforms to their RAEN director on the 20th of each month
- AEPP Regionals, RAEN, STAC, and Accountability office may choose to monitor either the in-person classes or the remote classes at any time
- Given their challenging schedules, they will monitor when available, no prior notice is necessary
